Introduction

1. In accordance to the UNEP/MAP Programme of Work and Budget for 2018-2019 (Decision IG.23/14) adopted by the 20th Ordinary Meeting of the Contracting Parties to the Barcelona Convention (Tirana, Albania, 17-20 December 2017), and on the kind collaboration of the Government of Italy, the Specially Protected Areas Regional Activity Centre (SPA/RAC) is convening the meeting of the Ecosystem Approach Correspondence Group on Monitoring (CORMON), Biodiversity and Fisheries. The meeting will be held on 21 May 2019, in Rome, Italy, at the Hôtel Holiday Inn (Viale Castello della Magliana, 65, 00148 Rome, Italy).

2. The main objectives of this CORMON meeting are to:

- (i) review and discuss the proposed guidelines on monitoring common indicators related to biodiversity and non-indigenous species; and
- (ii) discuss and provide guidance on the development of data standards and data dictionaries, required for the development of the IMAP compatible information and data sharing system.

3. The meeting will be invited to provide suggestions, comments and recommendations on further work on indicators in order to revise and finalize the monitoring guidelines for consideration by the 14th Meeting of SPA/BD Focal Points (Portorož, Slovenia, 18-21 June 2019).

4. The following annotations to the provisional agenda have been prepared by the Secretariat to assist the meeting with its deliberations.

c) Adoption of the agenda

10. Subject to Rule 14 of the rules of procedure, the provisional agenda appearing in document UNEP/MED WG.474/1 and annotated in the present document will be reviewed and proposed for adoption by the meeting, including the timetable contained in the annex to the present document.

d) Organization of work

11. The meeting will take place on Tuesday 21 May 2019. Sessions are scheduled, from 9.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and from 2.30 to 5.30 p.m.

12. It is expected that the meeting addresses all items of the agenda within the allotted sessions. It is envisaged to close the meeting at 5.30 p.m., after adopting its Conclusions and Recommendations.

13. Working languages of the meeting will be English and French. Simultaneous interpretation will be available during the plenary sessions of the meeting.

16. Draft monitoring guidelines on the three types of benthic habitats (marine vegetation, coralligenous and other Calcareous Bio-concretions as well as dark habitats) are developed in order to better assist countries in the implementation of their national IMAP as well as to harmonize and standardize monitoring and assessment methods as well as to further assess progress towards Good Environmental Status (GES).

17. The Secretariat will present an update of the guidelines on monitoring cetaceans, monk seal, seabirds, marine turtles and non-indigenous species, related to IMAP Common Indicators 3, 4, 5 and 6. The document UNEP/MED WG.474/Inf.3 is updated in light of the comments raised by the Contracting Parties within the first 2018-2019 CORMON meeting (Marseille, France, 12-13 February 2019).

18. The Secretariat will bring for information the Joint GFCM-UN Environment/MAP Sub-Regional Pilot Study for the Eastern Mediterranean on Non-Indigenous Species in Relation to Fisheries (UNEP/MED WG.474/Inf.4).

19. Participants will be invited to provide suggestions, comments and recommendations on further work on the draft guidelines in order to revise and finalize them for consideration by the 14th Meeting of SPA/BD thematic Focal Points (Portorož, Slovenia, 18-21 June 2019).
